



e) Small scale residential proposals of a scale and type that meet a locally agreed need




- ✓ well related to the existing settlement

Local Plan supports **appropriate** development in the form of **appropriate** housing at local level.


E.g. starter homes.


Defined in Housing and Planning Act 2016 as "a new dwelling only available for purchase by qualifying first-time buyers and which is made available at price which is at least 20% less than its market value but which is below the price cap (£250,000)

The total accommodation type figures taken from Census (2011) data for Upton Grey and The Candovers are as follows:






Housing Need for the Parish
