






Increases in the number of new cases compared to previous months.

The numbers in each percentage column show the rate at which the current increase in the number of new cases is exceeding that of the previous month. With only half the month of January past, most of the districts are already showing many more new cases than in the previous whole month (more than 100%). When the number falls below 100% in each successive month it will indicate that the pandemic is starting to get under control.

Old Basing & the Candovers

Old Basing & the Candovers at 10 January. Now into the "red" zone with a rising number of active cases – 37 and a rate of 478.3 per 100,000.

Seven-day running totals in local areas



These charts show the number of active new cases running over seven days to 10 January, five days behind the current date and is only indicative of the current situation as all areas now seem to be indicating a reducing pattern.

Four Marks & Medstead

The MSOA of Four Marks and Tisted, which includes Upper and Lower Wield, has been consistently showing a higher number of active cases than surrounding areas. It is now down to 23 active cases on 10 Jan, a rate of 187.2





Proportion of the local population diagnosed with covid-19 since the pandemic began










Deaths each week in Hampshire districts

Difference over six months



Contrast the difference in the coronavirus situation in Britain today and the position six months ago following the three-month lockdown which, essentially, kept the virus under control until September. Left map is the situation on 10 January and right is position on 19 July last year. The yellow area shows less than ten people with the virus on a rolling seven-day basis in each MSOA – small local areas. The black area on the current map shows there are more than 800 people, and the dark red more than 400 people in each MSOA.
