## *Coronavirus in Hampshire – update June 2021*

After many weeks of declining numbers of new cases of covid-19 in Hampshire, in single figures for most council districts during April and May, the new Indian variant (now called Delta) arrived in the county at the beginning of June.

As in most of the rest of Britain this new strain of the disease is having a big impact across the county and is gaining momentum. In the last week of May there were 194 new cases in the county, the first week of June saw the number rise to 286, and in the last seven days there were 2123 new cases. It reached its peak, so far, yesterday (5 July) with 368 new cases across the county.

In the districts more local to the Candover Valley, Basingstoke and Deane recorded 674 new cases since the beginning of June, and now has a seven-day rate of 184.6 per 100,000 of population. East Hampshire has 327 more cases and a rate of 122.6, Winchester has 397 and a rate of 157.8, while Test Valley has 495 and a rate of 156.2, and Hart has 189 and a rate of 143.2.

Regrettably, there has also been another 14 deaths in the county since 31 May attributed to coronavirus.

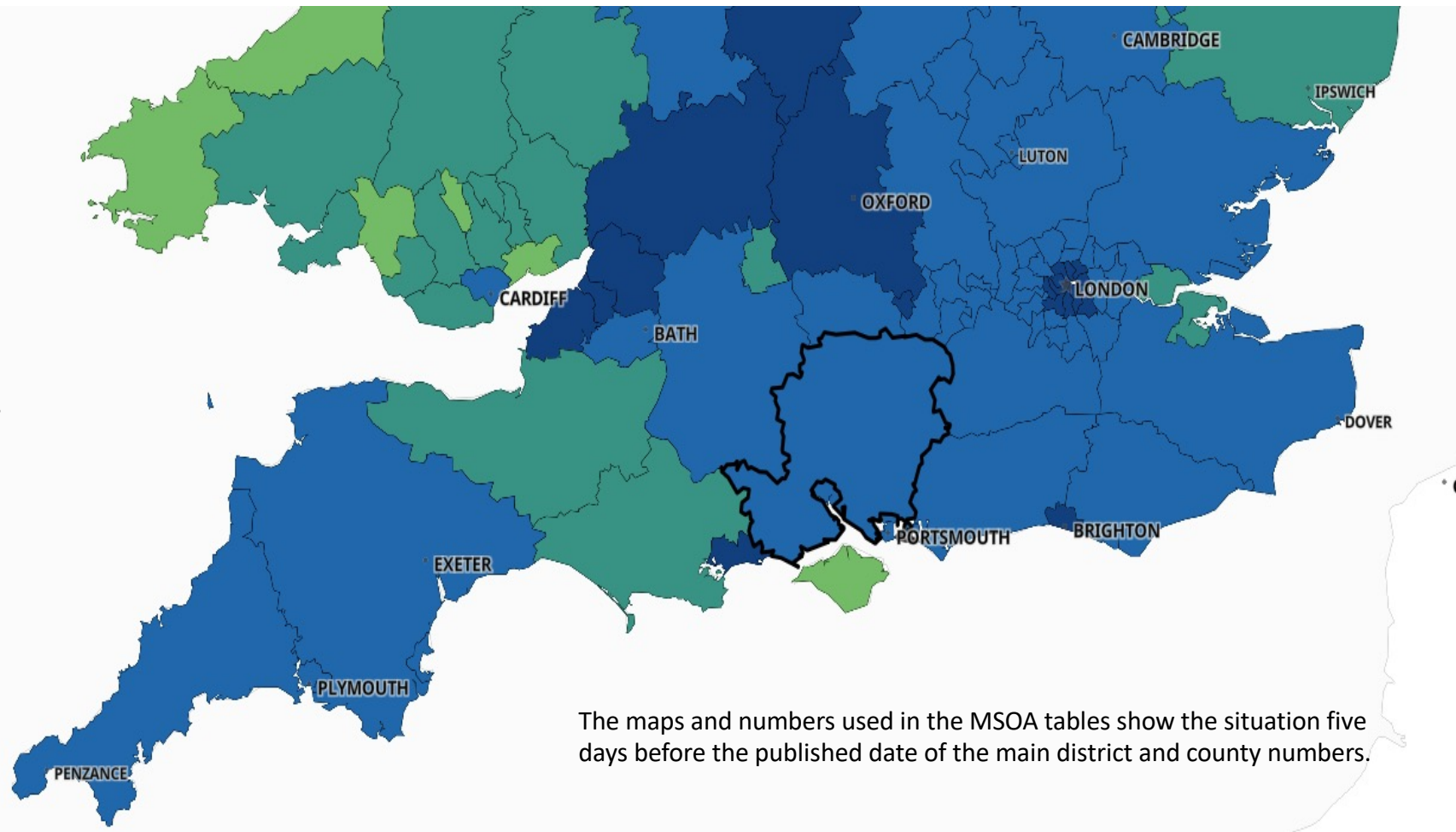

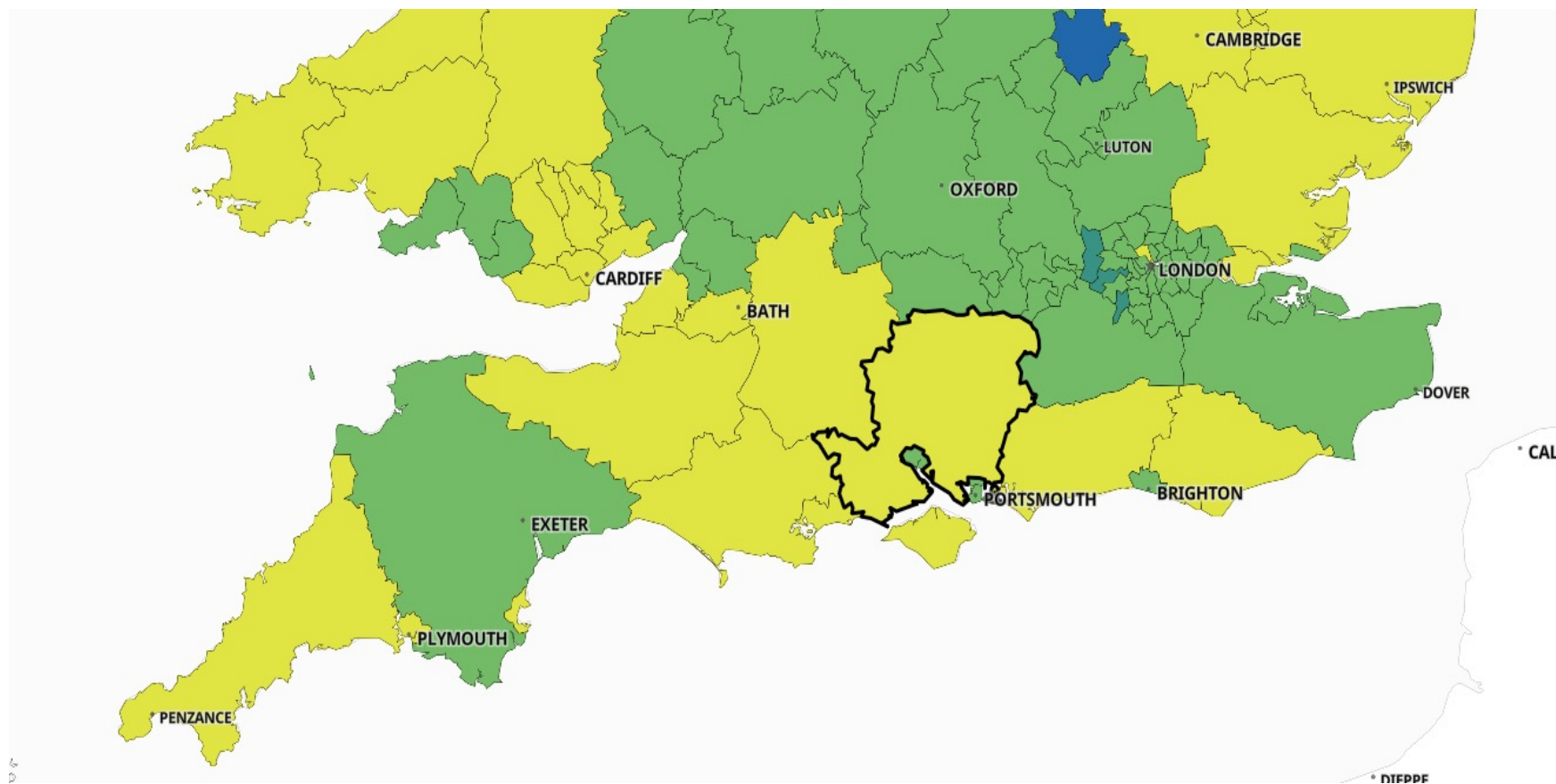

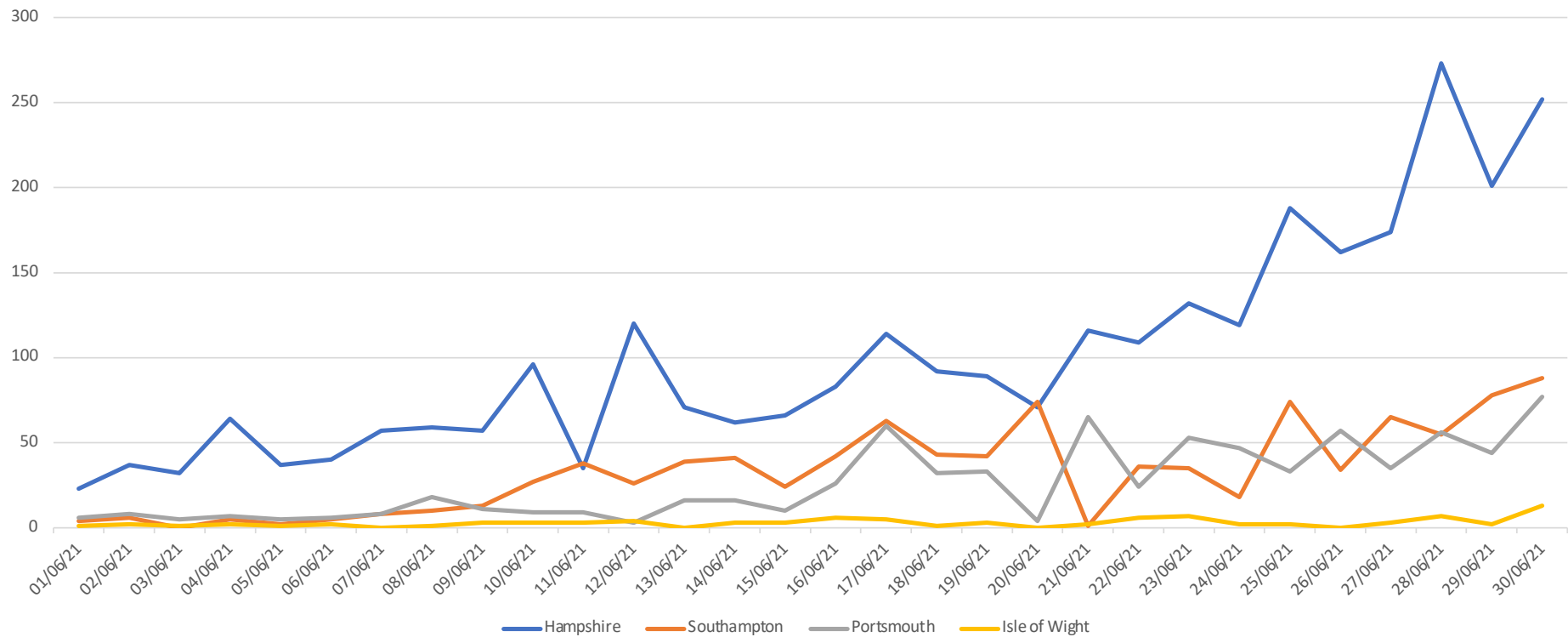

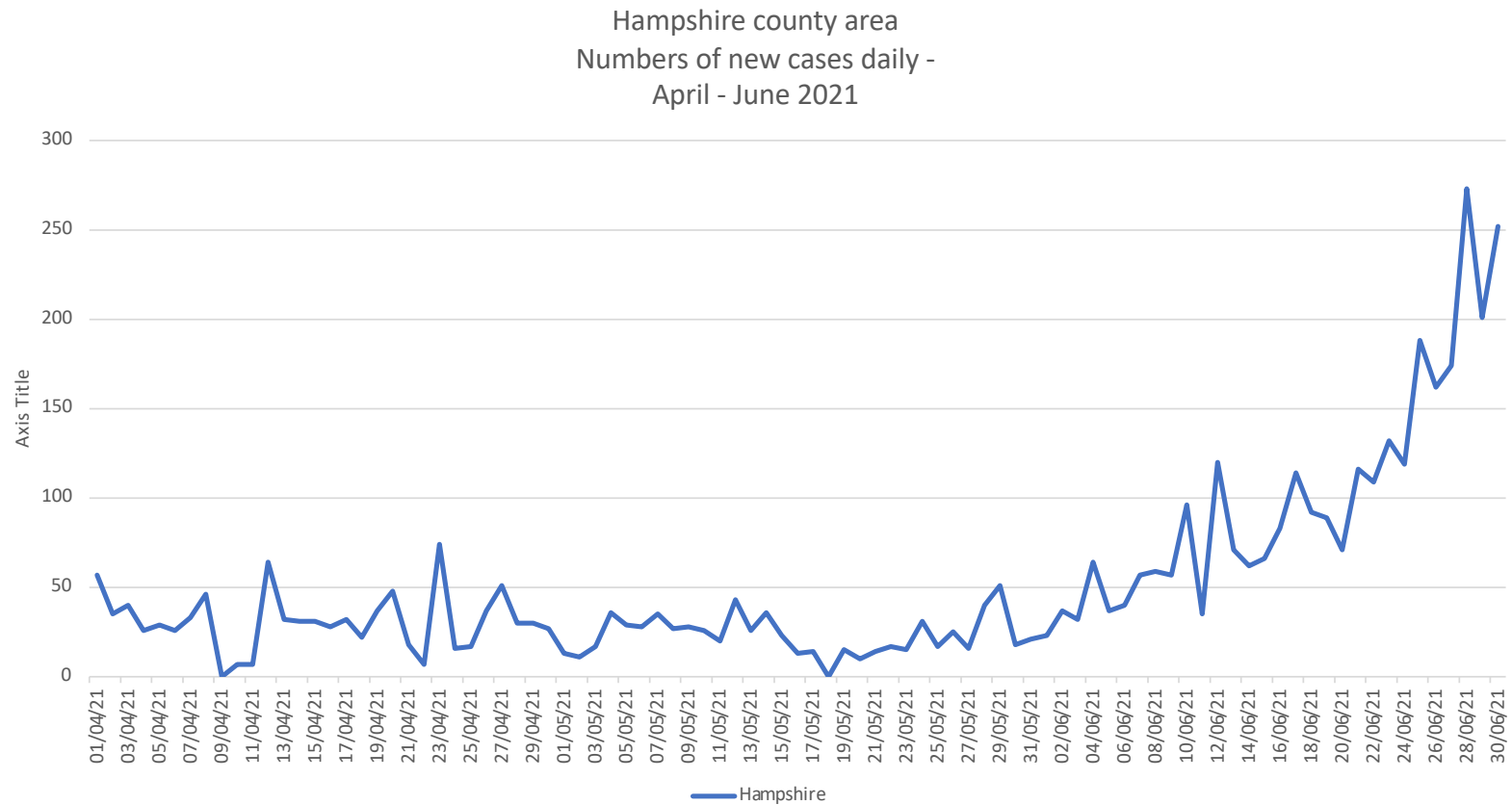


# Upper tier authorities in Hampshire – June 2021

June 2021



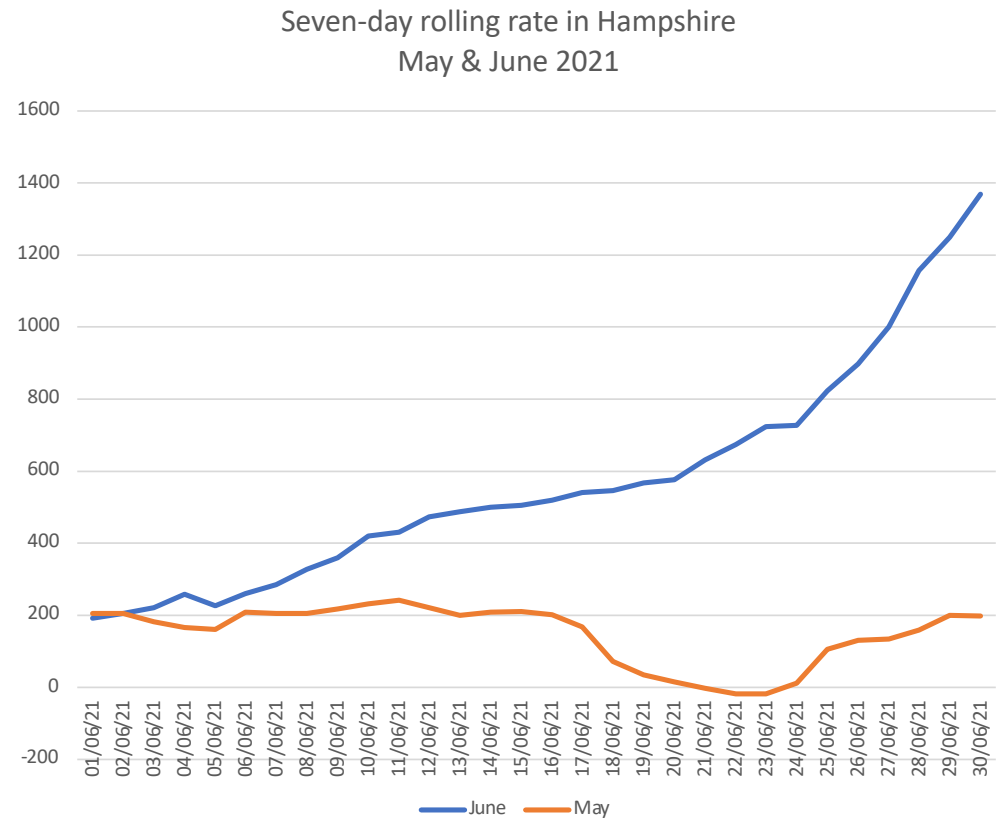

# Seven-day rolling rate of new cases – May & June 2021

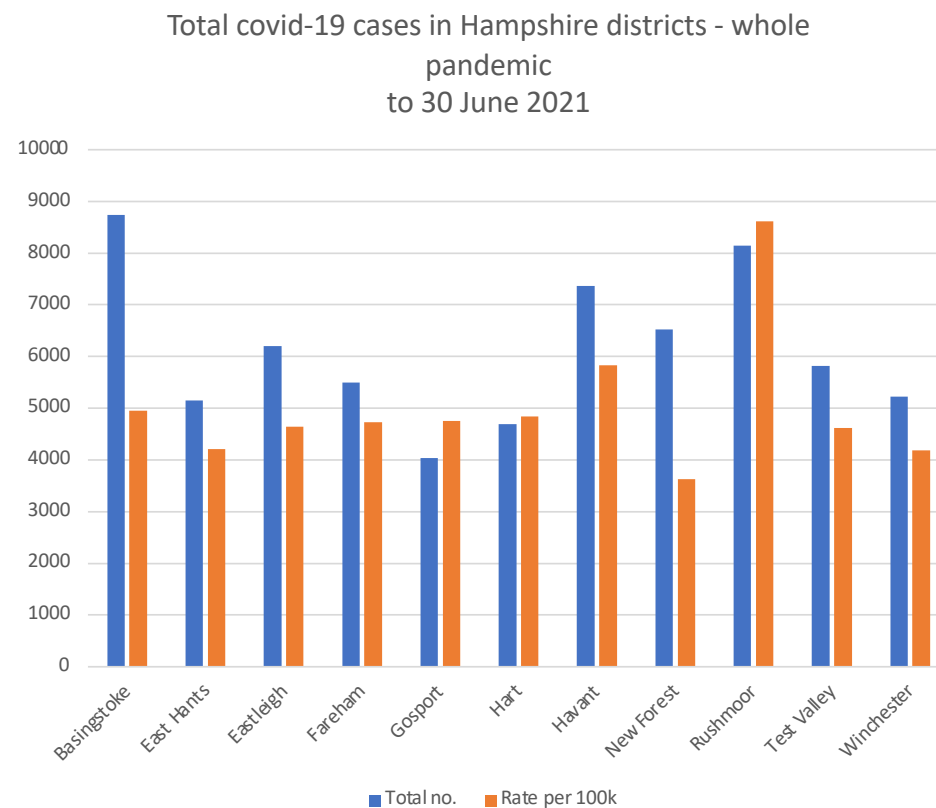
This chart illustrates the impact of the new Indian (Delta) variant of coronavirus in Hampshire during May and June.

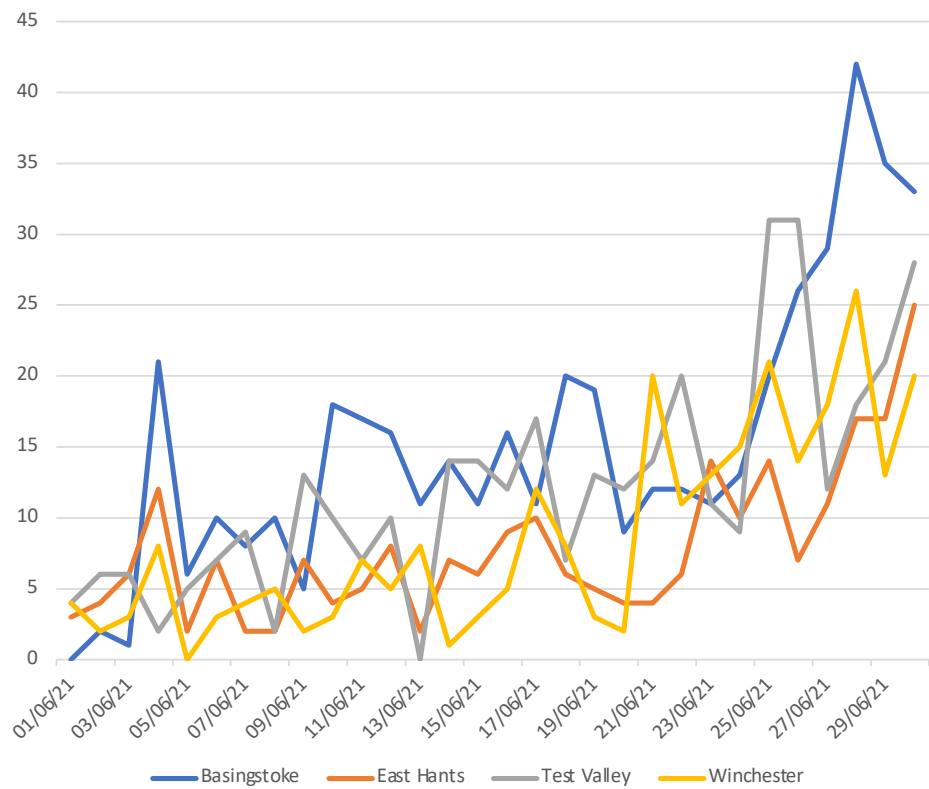

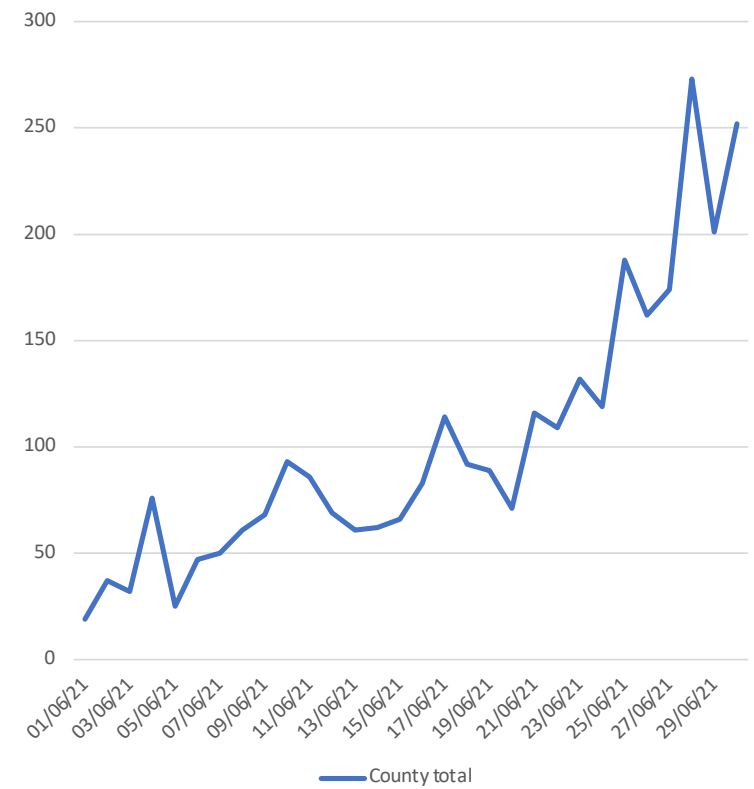

June 2021

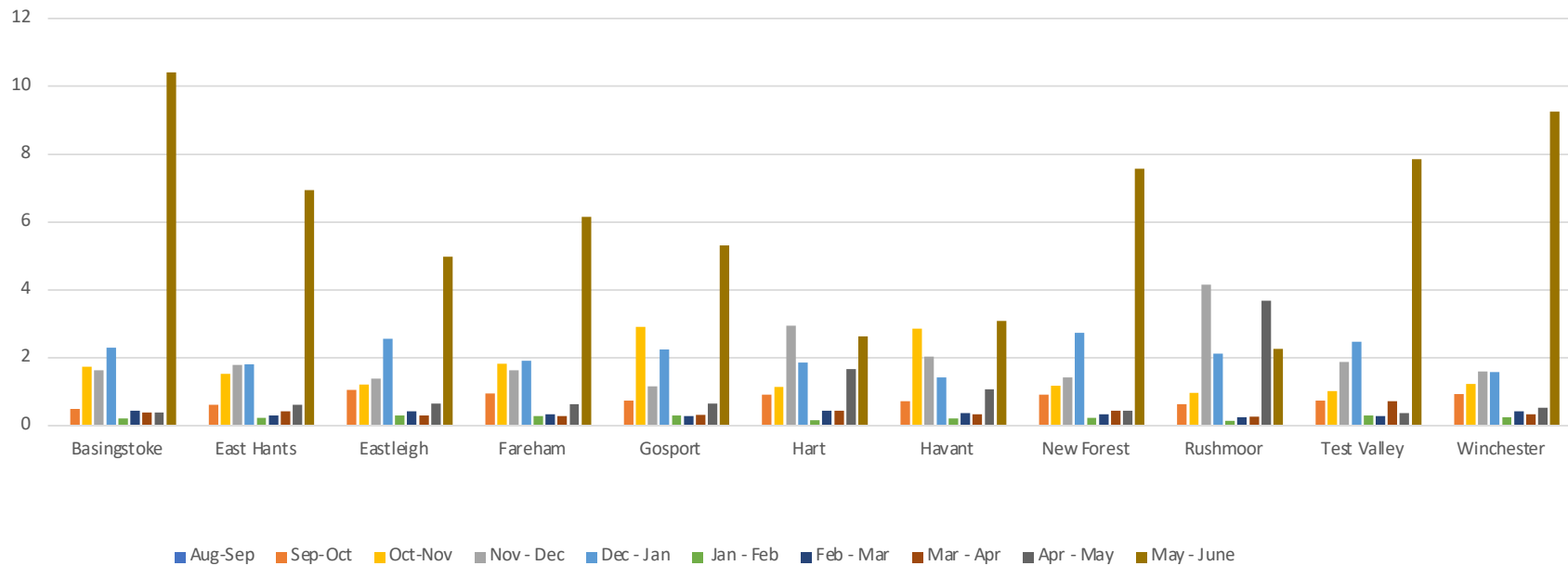


Covid-19 new cases daily in Hampshire county  
June 2021



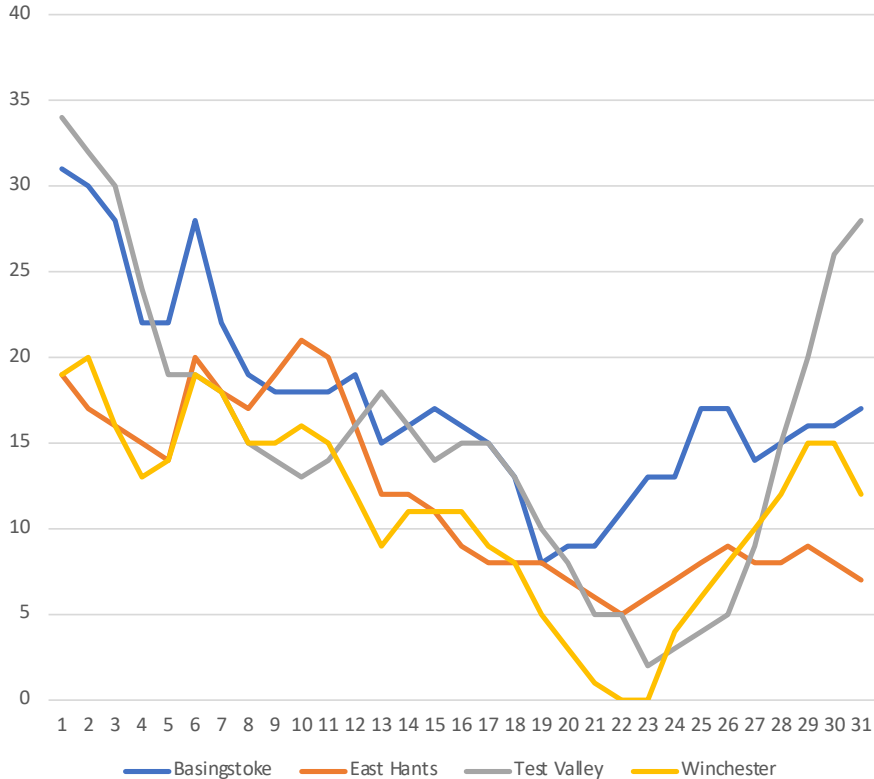
# *Month on month increases in rate of infection percentage of local populations*

month on month 1 September 2020 to 30 June 2021

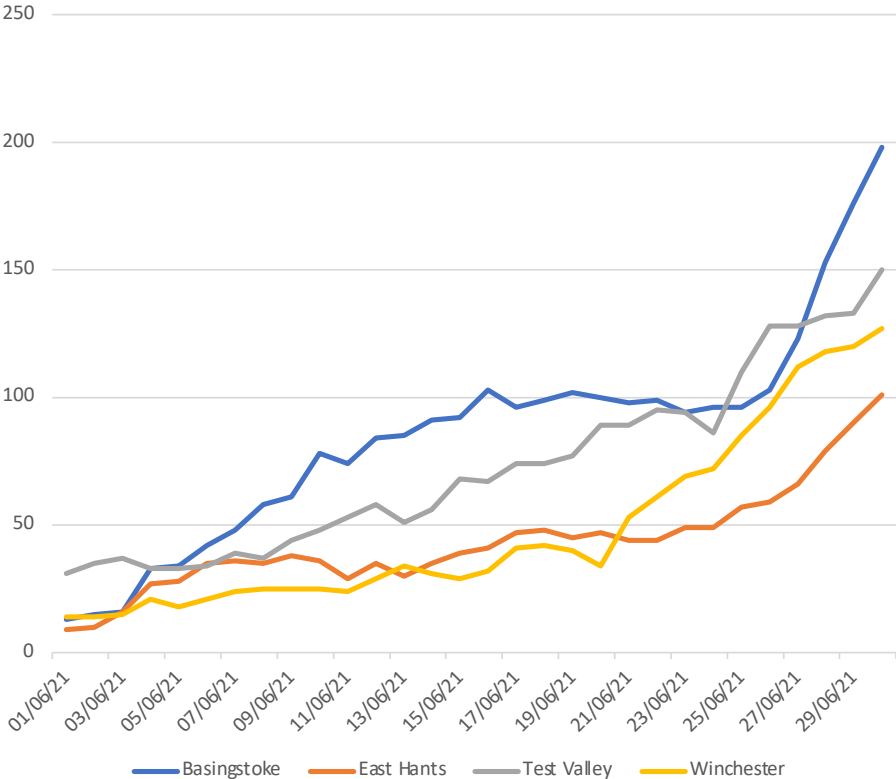


# Seven-day rolling rates – May & June 2021

May 2021

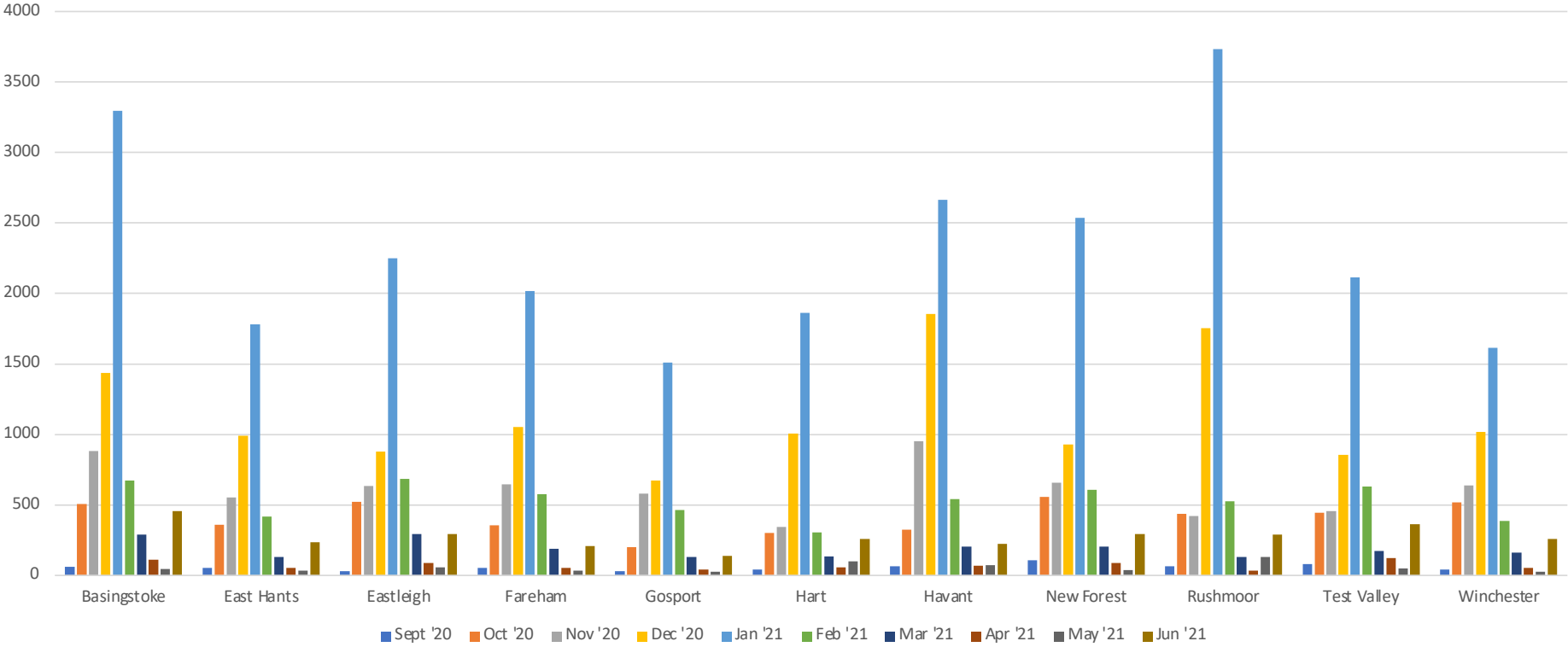


Seven-day rolling rate in mid Hampshire

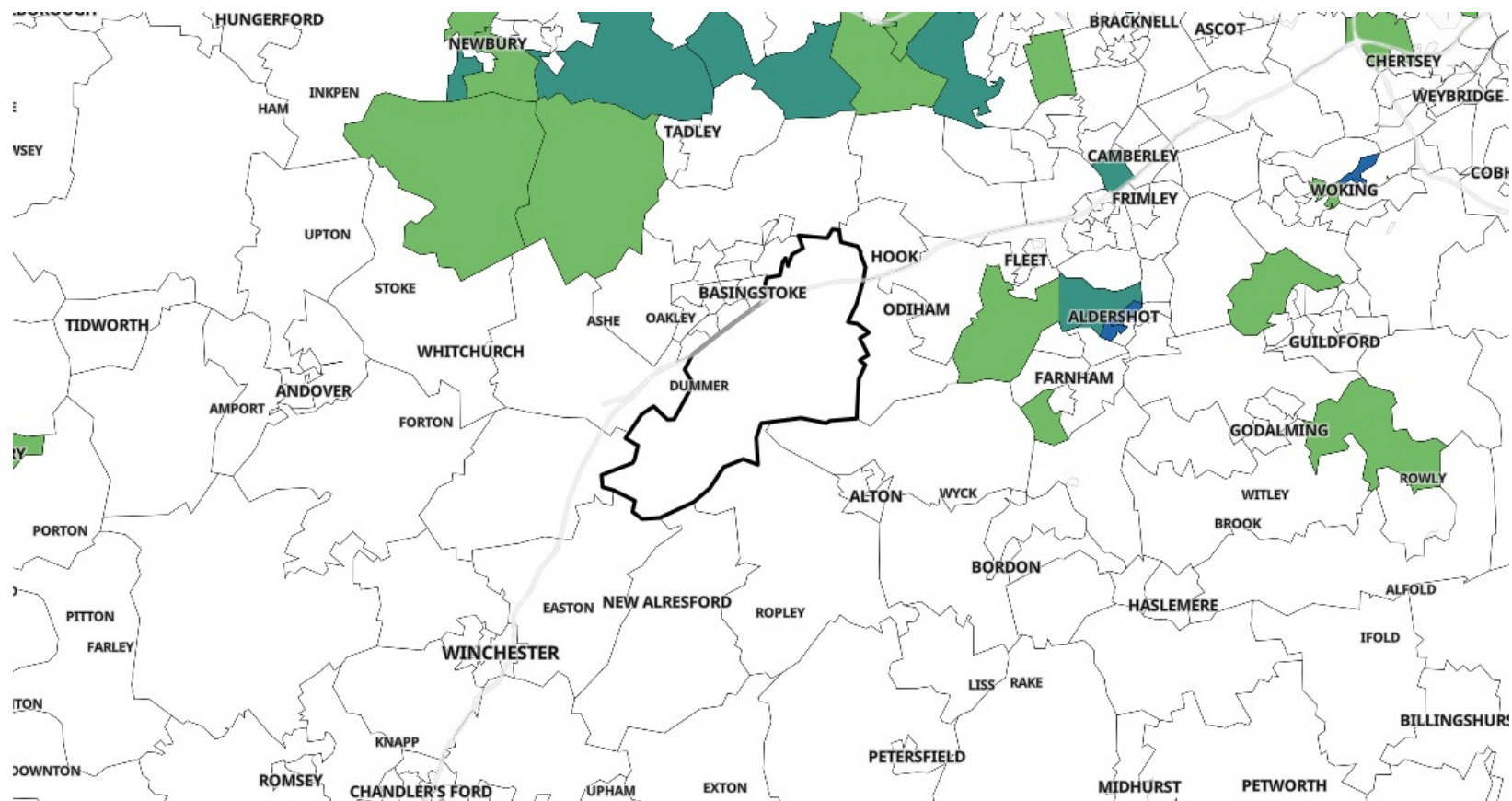

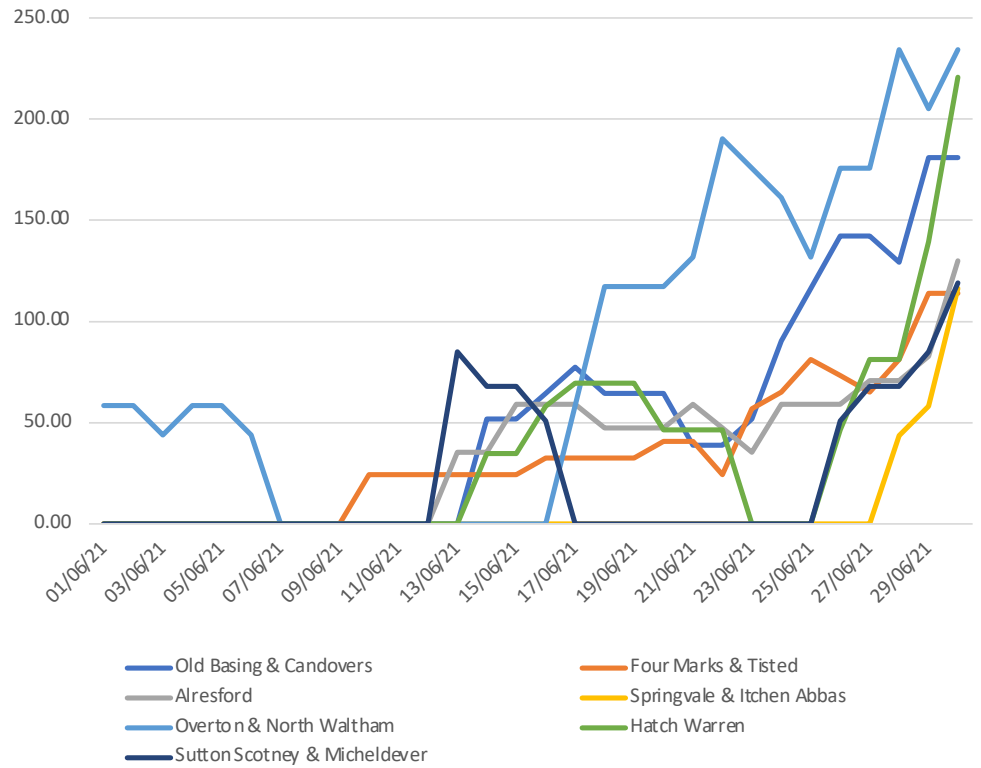


# Local MSOAs to Candover Valley – June 2021

30 June 2021

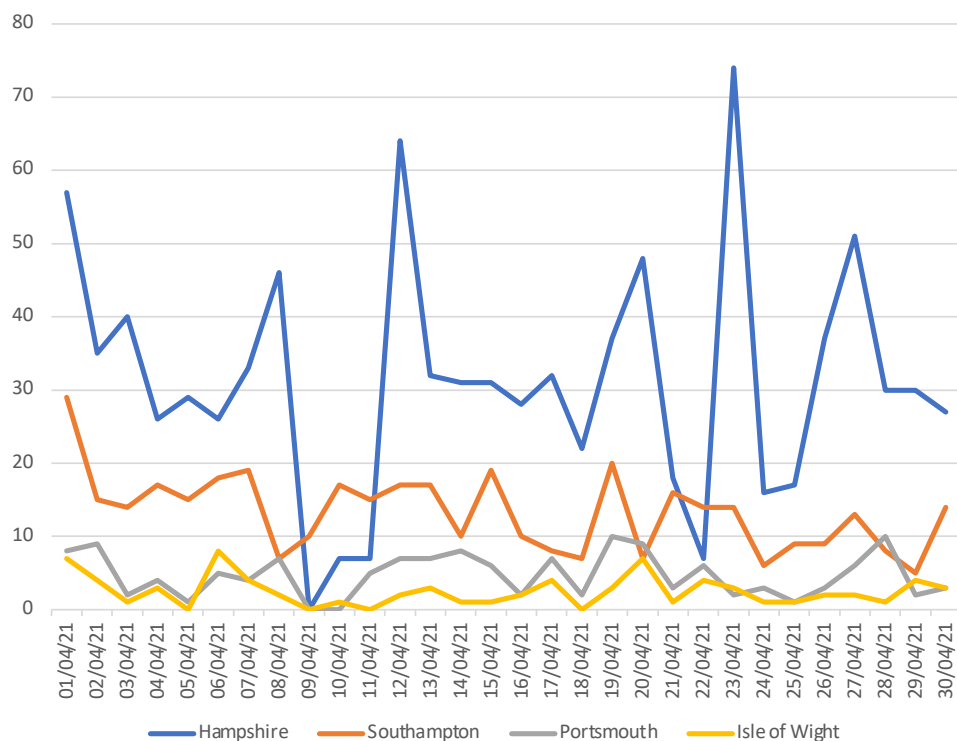


MSOAs Rolling seven-day rate per 100k  
June 2021

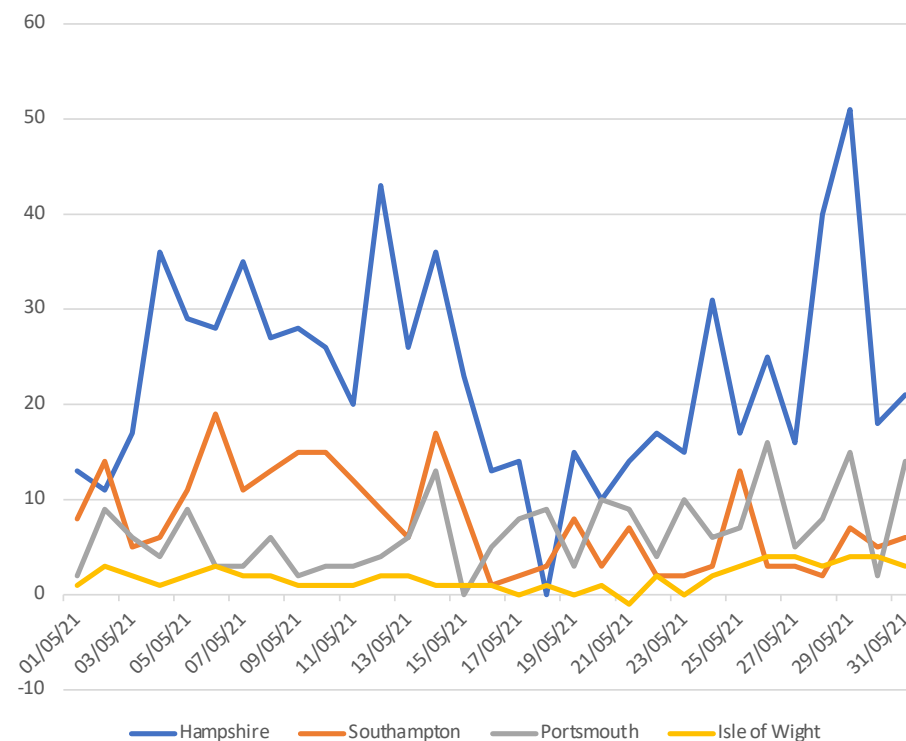

April 2021



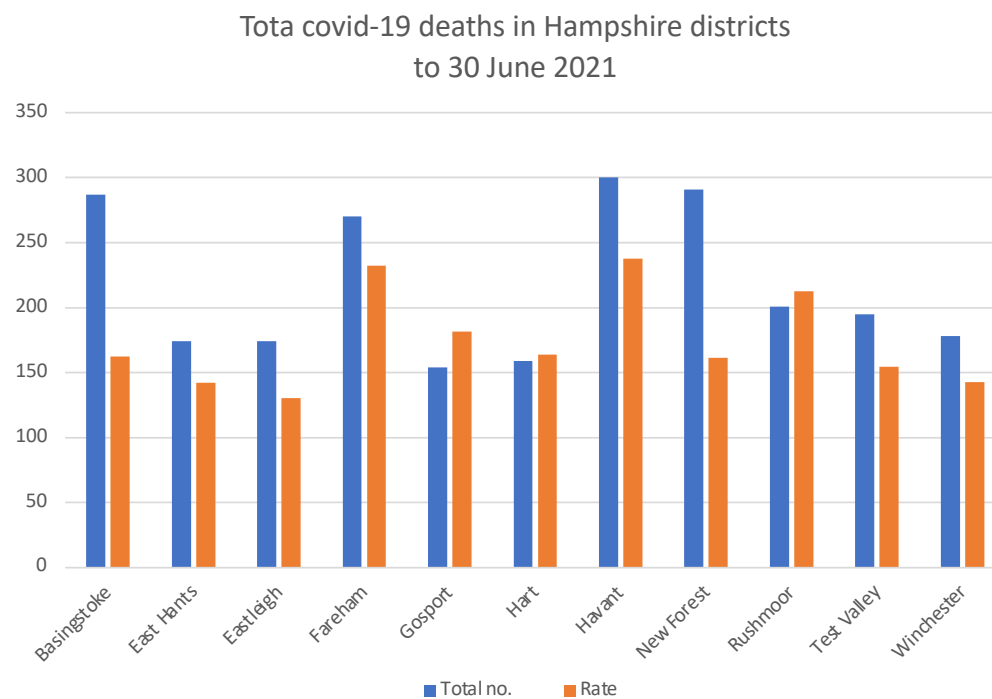
Number of new cases daily -

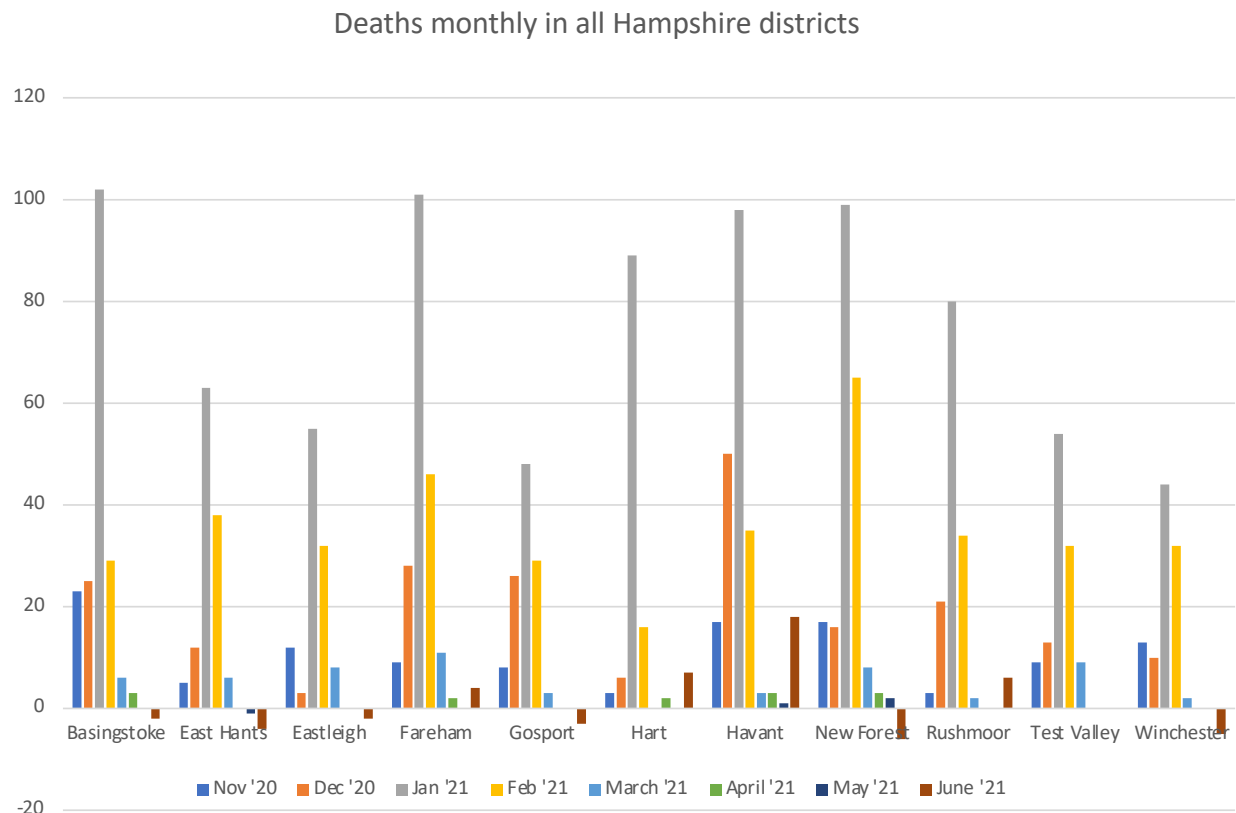


# Number of deaths from covid-19 each month

The total number of deaths in Hampshire attributed to coronavirus totalled 2383 at the end of June 2021, equivalent to just 1.72% of the county population. But each one was a tragedy for many people.

The peak month was January 2021 when the county recorded 833 deaths. But the success of the vaccination programme has reduced the number with 13 recorded in Hampshire in June. In certain districts the number has gone down, but risen in others as a result of a change in the system for recording locations.

The above numbers do not include deaths in Southampton, Portsmouth and the Isle of Wight. The total number of deaths at end June for these are 326, 365 and 256 respectively.

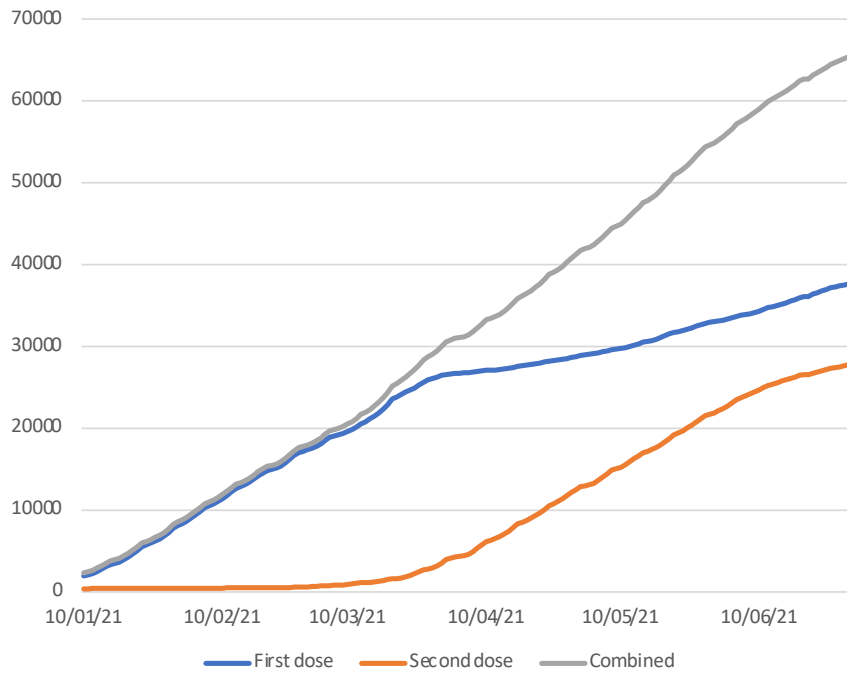

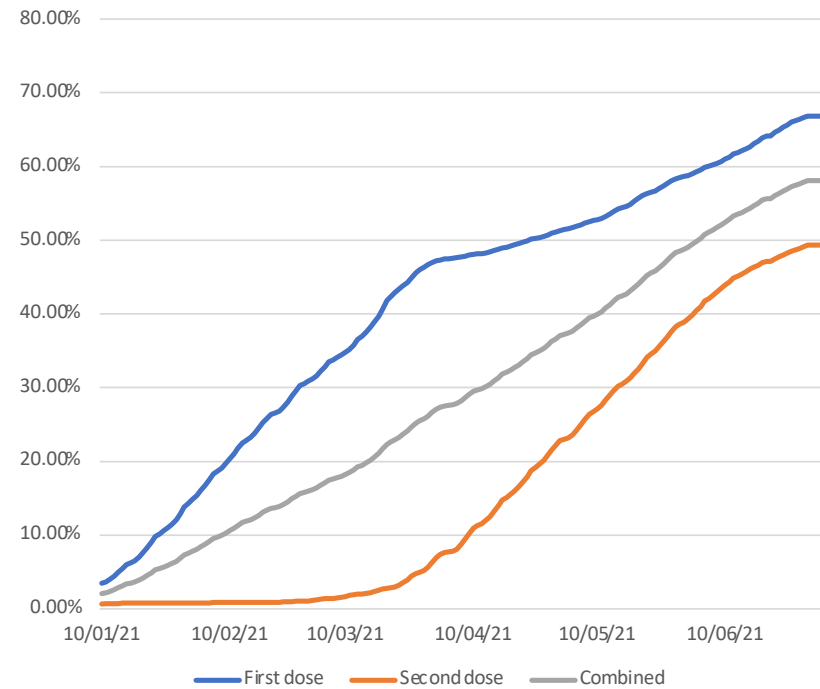
# Coronavirus vaccinations in England

## *Covid vaccinations in Hampshire*

At the end of June 37,618,263 people, equal to 66.8% of the population of England had received their first dose of the vaccination and 27,776,525 of these had already received their second dose.

Extrapolating these numbers to Hampshire would indicate that 923,965 had received their first dose of the vaccine by June 30, and 682,236 had received their second dose.
